1. Host Tournament Director (HTD): Welcome
2. HTD: Introduction of attendees (Umpire-in-Chief, Southeast Regional Representative, and other KEY personnel).
3. HTD: Important information about the Host facilities:
 - Are animals allowed
 - People to contact for assistance
 - Special events
4. HTD: Before, during, and after games:
 - Conduct of managers, coaches, players, and parents while on site and at hotels
 - Other items of concern or interest
5. Umpire-in-Chief
 - Everyone has a rule book
 - Plate meeting and lineup presentation
6. Southeast Regional Representative: Special emphasis on certain rules such as:
 - Pitch counts
 - Intentional-walk rule
 - Trips to mound
 - Re-entry rule
 - Extra Player (EP) rule (if you start with the EP, you must finish with the EP. If the team only has 10 players, then suggest that the EP not be used; if a player gets injured and cannot continue, there will be no one to take his or her place which will create a forfeiture of the game).
 - The Official Scorer is the only "OFFICIAL" scorekeeper.
 - Protests (Rule 11.05, paragraphs 2 and 9 on pages 25 and 28)
 - The manager is responsible for the sportsmanship and behavior of his or her team's parents and fans.
 - A Championship team photo will be taken of each of the two final teams prior to the start of the championship game. The game will not start until these photos are taken.
